## Learning at home

### Verse to begin

Like at school, if you would like you can say the verse before starting the lesson:

*"I think about the world  
I hold it in my Heart  
My hands I use for work  
May these three play their part"*

This is how the blanket stitch looks, the last set of instructions explain how to more directly



## Step 1:

If you have your stuffing wool you can roll a small amount into the tip of the trunk, if you don't have any wool, no need to worry, keep sewing down the leg until you reach the feet, but please don't sew up the feet!



## Step 2: The Tail

Once you have sewn up all the legs, you will have a perfect space left to place the tail.

Thread your needle and fold over the tail and you can do a simple fence stitch for this part. It is very fiddly so take your time.





Then sew it into place with quite a few stitches and fill the gap with blanket stitches.

### Step 3: The Feet

Taking the spare felt in your craft bag, get a pen and mark a basic line of how wide your feet are. Move your Elephant and make a circle within that mark, cut out the circle and then use the cut out circle to cut out 3 more.





The feet are quite tricky to sew on, so take your time and make sure you hide your knot. The next instructions will be up very soon, where we will stuff the elephant and sew on the ears.
